Paul Savage and Scott Bernard will give a presentation on the past, present, and future of the 12 Meter class, the magnificent yachts that contested the America's Cup between 1958 and 1987. Since then, many 12 Meters remain active in chartering out of Newport, RI. And in 2019 the next world championship of the class will be sailed off Newport.

Paul and Scott are actively involved with the class and next year's championship. Their talks will be illustrated with splendid pictures of the 12 Meters in action.

Our venue is City Island Yacht Club, where following the talks there will be a buffet dinner. This event also includes a tour of the City Island Nautical Museum, where many of the 12s were built.



Presenters on the 12's:

Paul Savage, a recent Corinthian, has 45 years racing experience in 12 Meters and many other boats. He has skippered five 12 Meters and has assembled our current program about them. He is actively involved in the quest to enter a team in the 12 Meter World Championships in 2019.

Scott Bernard is the current owner of *Easterner*, built for the America's cup in 1958 and since actively raced and chartered on the West Coast and currently out of Newport. Scott is a former Navy aviator and a university professor. He currently works for the Executive Office of the President.


